

NSU TESTING SERVICES ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY

As an incoming student, you acknowledge that you will abide by the following Norfolk State University test integrity protocol.

- 1. Clear cell phones, smartwatches, calculators, books or other unauthorized items from desk or table (No testing from bed.)
- 2. No other computer monitors, screens, or tablets should be on during the test.
- 3. All communication devices, televisions, and audio devices in the room must be silenced.
- 4. Students are not allowed to talk or communicate with others during the proctor session.
- 5. Only the test-taker is permitted to enter the room once the exam is launched.
- 6. No headsets or earplugs are allowed.
- 7. Make sure that your full face is in view throughout the test.
- 8. Consequences for violating testing protocol may result in invalidation of test results.
