REFUND PROCESS FOR FALL 2009

The refund process will begin approximately seven working days after the last date of class cancellation (the last class cancellation date was August 27). Notifications will be sent to students via

their NSU e-mail accounts once refunds have been processed.

Students may enroll in the Direct Deposit program for student refunds using their SpartanShield account. Students who

do not have an active bank account may open a free student checking account online with Bank of America at <https://www4.bankofamerica.com/applyonline/> and select Campus Edge.

Refunds are given only after all University obligations are paid in full.
